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## FELLOWSHIP OF CHRISTIAN ATHLETES (FCA) GRANT PROGRAM

### What is the Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA)?

*Since 1954, the Fellowship of Christian Athletes has been challenging coaches and athletes on the professional, college, high school, junior high and youth levels to use the powerful medium of athletics to impact the world for Jesus Christ. FCA is the largest interdenominational, school-based, Christian sports organization in America.*

### What is FCA Camp?

Camps are a time of "inspiration and perspiration" for athletes and coaches to reach their potential by offering comprehensive athletic, spiritual and leadership training. Each attendee will experience:

- Unbelievable fun
- Outstanding sports training
- Awesome speakers
- Incredible friendships
- Life change

Sport-Specific Camps are for athletes and their coaches who want to develop their skills in one sport. Outstanding instructional skill development and competition prepare the camper for future athletic competition.

### How Can My Club Become Involved With FCA?

The Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA) grant program was established through a gift to the Kiwanis Cal-Nev-Ha Foundation to support Kiwanis clubs in sponsoring underprivileged students attending FCA Summer Camp. To assist clubs in this endeavor, the Kiwanis Cal-Nev-Ha Foundation makes available FCA grants, on a first come - first served basis, by providing a \$100 scholarship (per camper) (*Camp enrollment cost is dependent upon location of camp and age of student. Please visit [www.fcacamps.org](http://www.fcacamps.org) to determine enrollment costs*). Clubs wishing to sponsor more than one camper may request funding for additional campers; however, multiple requests will only be approved based on the availability of funds.

To participate in the FCA grant program, simply complete an FCA grant application. Please verify all information is both complete and correct to avoid delays in processing your application or mailing your check. *\*Please Note: Applying for grant funds does not automatically enroll your student in an FCA camp. You must contact FCA directly to enroll students in camp. If your grant is approved, you and your club agree to furnish the Kiwanis Cal-Nev-Ha Foundation with a follow-up grant report and funds expenditure report within 30 days of the end of the grant period. As part of your follow up report, we request photos, and if available, video clips and other data that would best convey how your grant was used and how providing this funding recognized the Kiwanis family.
